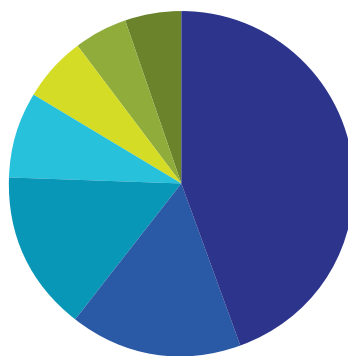

Iowa is home to the second largest acres of harvestable biomass. Forty-three processing facilities in Iowa produce more than 1/4 of U.S. ethanol, and 12 refineries produce 16% of U.S. biodiesel.



Iowa's legislature created America's first Biochemical Production Tax Credit in 2016, which the U.S. Department of Agriculture calls the "strongest existing incentive package for the global biobased chemical industry."
